Description of TSA(s) in 300 words or less: Our students take a series of FAA written and practical tests as they progress through the program. Each degree option represents a specific set of these tests. The written tests are conducted in FAA testing centers. The practical tests are conducted by FAA Designated Pilot Examiners. Both of these are external PCC.

Maximum score possible: The written test has a maximum score of 100%. The practical tests are pass/fail.

Benchmark score: The written tests have a minimum passing score of 70%. Without passing the written test, the student is not eligible for the practical test. The practical tests are pass/fail. **Clarifying notes**: We do not collect written test scores, but students cannot take the practical test without first passing the written with the minimum 70%. We can verify students have passed both written and practical tests by checking the FAA pilot database.
