These 4 questions have been determined by the CMET SAC and CMET's Industry Advisory Committee to be indicative of the type of information that a CMET graduate should have ascertained before graduation. These 4 questions are graded by the responsible Instructor and reported to Greg Gerstner in Spring quarter. Greg collects, correlates the data and gives a pass or no pass for every graduate from that current school year.

Maximum score possible: 100% average on all 4 questions

Benchmark score (score that "meets expectations" for completing students): 70% average for all 4 questions

Clarifying notes: All exam scores for graduates are available by the end of June for CMET.
