Description of TSA(s) in 300 words or less: The students are deemed as having met their TSAs if they pass the written Certified Ophthalmic Technician (COT) exam, administered by the Joint Commission on Allied Health Personnel in Ophthalmology (JCAHPO). The COT includes a three-hour written exam consisting of 200 multiple-choice questions, and a separate two-hour skill evaluation which is administered at a different time.

Maximum score possible: 100

Benchmark score (score that “meets expectations” for completing students): 70

Clarifying notes: (The OMT program is given the written test results immediately once the student has passed or not passed exam. This portion of the exam is what is currently being measured for the TSA in the OMT program. The skills exam test result is not available immediately, the OMT program anticipates these results within 4-6 weeks after the test is taken sometime in mid-July.)
