Term #1 - Fall Term - 1 comps

++ this term only - you cannot comp an exam until we have covered it in Rad 101 lecture.

Term #2 - Winter Term - 5 comps ++ each term you may complete up to the t

Term #3 - Spring Term - 8 comps of comps required for the following ter

Term #4 - Summer Term - 20 comps

Term #5 - Fall Term - 12 comps ++ Example: 1st term = 1 comps, 2nd term

Term #6 - Winter Term - 12 comps -- total possible comps for 1st term = 6

Term #7 - Spring Term - 20 comps

Term #8 - Summer Term - 10 comps, all required radiography comps & patient care comps

88 comps required by the end of Term #7 - (1+5+8+20+12+12+20+10)

Comp Log Statistics:

226 total possible comps

81 required radiography comps (see " minimum 3 sub categories must be completed" listed next to exam type)

• 44 specific radiography comps -- comps listed with a "*" and "R" (must be completed to graduate)

6 required patient care comps

++ you cannot complete competencies on exams that will be presented in future terms. Exams must be covered in same term or previous term lectures. See note under Term #1 above for additional rule.

++ not all competencies are eligible in the same term that the material is presented. Note the shaded areas on the comp. log. Shaded areas indicate that the competency may not be completed within that term.

(Example: Thumb presented 1st term - but trauma and surgical Thumb comps may not be done in 1st term.)

Term #8 Requirements:

+ complete any remaining required specific radiography comps

+ complete remaining terminal comps

Competency Completion Information:

+ successful comp completion indicates that you have proven yourself competent to perform that exam with minimal if any errors. (1st year students still need direct supervision on all exams - even if "comped")

+ comps can be taken away - which requires recertification - if your skills diminish

+ completion of comps does not release you from the need to perform those exams - in fact - you should perform those exams as often as possible to improve your exam speed, patient care skills and technical skills.

+ all required comps per term must be completed before finals week. If required comps are not completed before finals week your grade will be lowered and you may receive an incomplete(I). This can affect financial aide.

+ All comp forms must include the correct exam description, date and Technologist signature.

* The number of competencies completed on the same patient will be dictated by the Clinical Instructor at each clinical site
