

## Legend for College-Wide Assessment Project

Item	Definition
Artifact	Student's completed assignment as submitted for assessment
Benchmark	Performance level on a rubric identified as the minimum desirable score for all students
CTE	Career-Technical Education Denotes students pursuing a technical degree
Doubled-Scored	Single artifact scored by two raters Useful for determining inter-rater reliability
DSAC	Discipline Subject Area Committee Comprised of faculty whose disciplines belong to one General Education category. PCC's four DSACs are Arts & Letters; Science, Math, and Computer Science; Social Science; and Cultural Literacy (the last being a course designation within the other three groups)
Dimension	Criteria on a rubric PCC's rubrics generally include four or five dimensions upon which each artifact is rated
General Studies	Denotes students pursuing an Associate of General Studies (AGS) or those using AGS as a placeholder until they are accepted into a competitive CTE program
Gwet	Measure of statistical significance developed by Kilem L. Gwet
IRR	Inter-Rater Reliability Degree to which two or more scorers agree on each rubric dimension when scoring a single artifact
Pell	Federal Pell grant Demographic that identifies Pell-eligible students
Rogue Rater	Rater whose scores are significantly and consistently higher or lower than other scorers in their cohort
Transfer	Denotes students pursuing a transferable degree
Under-rep	Under-represented Student who self-identifies as Afro American, Hispanic, Native American, or Multiracial
